



## **Dr. John Bell**

Dr Bell is an Irish national and has been a European Commission official since 1993. During his career he has worked on financial aid assistance programmes in the former Yugoslavia and in Albania, as well as public administration reform programmes in Central and Eastern Europe. He was also a Member of the Cabinet of Commissioner David Byrne with responsibility for enlargement, public health and global health security issues, including bioterrorism, and Head of Cabinet for the first Bulgarian European Commissioner Meglena Kuneva on Consumer Affairs. Mr Bell is currently Head of Cabinet of the European Commissioner for Research, Innovation and Science, Máire Geoghegan-Quinn.

His academic career began at University College Dublin where he completed his undergraduate and Masters Degree focussing on Anglo Irish studies. After a short spell in business journalism in London, he completed his Doctorate at St John's College, Oxford University in 1993.
